1. The Super One Series Ltd will organise Round 11 and 12 for Honda, Rotax, ROK & Bambino classes on 29 & 30 August 2020 at Shenington
2. **Jurisdiction**
This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Super One Series Ltd and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. **Eligibility**
The event is open to all fully-elected members of Registered drivers of the Super One Series.
All entrants must produce a club membership card/Super One Licence.
Class Regulations as per Super One Series General Regulations.
4. **Championships**
The event is a round of the Super One Series.
5. **Scrutineering/Programme**
Scrutineering starts at 08:00 hrs on DATE at CIRCUIT.
6. **Event Start**
The event will start at 09:00 hrs
Nature of start: Official Practice
Any competitor not signed on by 09:00 hrs may be excluded.
7. **Description of Event**
There will be Official testing, timed qualifying and two finals, heats and finals.
The track measures 1018 metres and the number of corners is 9, the surface is tarmac.
The following classes will apply: Honda, Rotax, ROK & Bambino classes
8. **Vehicles Starting Positions**
Rolling starts. Honda and Bambino standing starts.
9. **Practice Requirements**
Practicing will be a minimum of one 8 minute session.
10. **Identification**
Identification numbers will be issued by the organisers.
11. **Pits Area**
Entry to the circuit is from Thursday from 09:00 hrs.
No pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, footballs, roller skates or similar in the pits. Ball games in the pits or on the circuit are not allowed. All drivers remember you are responsible for all persons connected with you. You may be excluded from the meeting if this regulation is not complied with.
It is forbidden to damage property, including new facilities, crops or surrounding area which include pegging down awnings or washing down engine and karts with combustible or hazardous materials.
The running of karts and their engines is NOT permitted in the pits unless in an area designated by the Scrutineer.
12. **Judges of Fact**
All Officials are Judges of Fact.
13. **Filming**
As per Championship Regulations.
14. **Awards**
Awards will be presented as follows: As per Championship Regulations.
15. **Entries**
The maximum entry for classes is 34 and the minimum is 10. Should any of these figures not be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel that class at this event.
16. **Entry List**
The entry list opens on the Super One website and closes finally on 15 August 2020 at 17:00 hrs.
All entries must be made online on the Super One website.
17. **Entry Fee**
The entry fee is £180.00 for Saturday and Sunday. No refunds are given. Optional Friday Practice £55.00
