**Supplementary Regulations**

1. The Super One Series Ltd will organise Round 11 & 12 on 27&28 August 2022 at Shenington for Bambino C50 New Era, Bambino C50 Pro, Bambino IAME, Honda Cadet, Mini Rok and Junior Rok, Senior Rok, Mini Max, Junior Max, Senior Max, and 177 Max. A demonstration race will be held for Micro Max.
2. **Jurisdiction**  
This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Super One Series Ltd and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. **Eligibility**  
The event is open to all fully-elected members of Registered drivers of the Super One Series.  
All entrants must produce a club membership card/Super One Licence.  
Class Regulations as per Super One Series General Regulations.
4. **Championships**  
The event is 2 rounds of the Super One Series.
5. **Scrutineering/Programme**  
Online Scrutineering declaration and details to be submitted before Time Qualifying.
6. **Event Start**  
The event will start at 09:00 hrs on Saturday and 9:00 hrs on Sunday.  
Nature of start: Official Practice or Timed Qualifying  
Any competitor not signed on by 09:00 hrs may be excluded.
7. **Description of Event**  
There will be Official testing, timed qualifying and two heats and a final.  
The track measures 1018 metres and the number of corners is 9, the surface is tarmac.  
The following classes will apply: C50 New Era, Bambino C50 Pro, Bambino IAME, Honda Cadet, Mini Rok and Junior Rok, Senior Rok, Mini Max, Junior Max, Senior Max, and 177 Max
8. **Vehicles Starting Positions**  
Practice and TQ grid positions will be in Championship order. Rolling starts. Honda and Bambino standing starts.
9. **Practice Requirements**  
Practicing will be a minimum of one 6 minute session.
10. **Identification**  
Identification numbers must be displayed on all 4 sides of the kart and Official Super One numbers can be purchased from the Race Centre.
11. **Pits Area**  
Entry to the circuit is from Thursday from 9:00 hrs.  
No pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, footballs, roller skates or similar in the pits. Ball games in the pits or on the circuit are not allowed. All drivers remember you are responsible for all persons connected with you. You may be excluded from the meeting if this regulation is not complied with.  
It is forbidden to damage property, including new facilities, crops or surrounding area which include pegging down awnings or washing down engine and karts with combustible or hazardous materials.  
The running of karts and their engines is NOT permitted in the pits unless in an area designated by the Scrutineer.
12. **Judges of Fact**  
All Officials are Judges of Fact.
13. **Filming**  
As per Championship Regulations.
14. **Awards**  
Awards will be presented as follows: As per Championship Regulations.
15. **Entries**  
The maximum entry for classes is 34 and the minimum is 10. Should any of these figures not be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel that class at this event.
16. **Entry List**  
All entries must be made online on the Super One Alpha System.
17. **Entry Fee**  
The entry fee is £185.00 for Saturday and Sunday. No refunds are given. Optional Friday Practice £60.00
18. **Refusal of Entries**  
As per regulation 2.1.6.
19. **Additional Entry Information**  
When entering online all fields must be completed.
20. **Postponement/Cancellation**  
As per Championship Regulations.

**Shenington Kart Circuit Rules & Regulations**

- Do not drive through Shenington and Alkerton villages (unless using B&B or the pub in the village), use the route on the SKRC website [Contact Us – Shenington Kart Racing Club \(sheningtonkrc.co.uk\)](http://sheningtonkrc.co.uk)
- Do not bring electric scooters or similar battery powered personal vehicles. If seen there is firstly a fine of £100 and thereafter expulsion from the site
- Other scooters and bicycles must not be used whilst karts are on track, otherwise fine of £50.
- Do not pit in the grass fields, if open they are for cars parking. No pitting is allowed in the tarmac areas surrounding the clubhouse. There are no power outlets for competitors.
- Do not park cars in the paddock unless working from it, park in the grass field car park. No parking or pitting in the Bruce Hopkins car park in front of his business.
- Maximum speed in the paddock for vehicles is 5mph. The driving of motor vehicles for which the driver is not authorised under RTA legislation is forbidden.
- Commercial teams must have a minimum of £5 million public liability insurance. Proof may be requested.
- Competitors must have their own fire extinguisher, this may be checked.
- Do not drive karts in the paddock, first offence £50, second offence expulsion from the site
- Be polite to all officials and marshals, never take matters into your own hands, report any issues. Officials are volunteers there to give you an enjoyable day. Abuse will result in expulsion.
- Do not leave any tyres or fuel cans behind, fine of £10 per tyre or can. Your pit area will be checked at the end of the meeting.
- If the turnstile one way system from the dummy grid to the grandstand is open, it is strictly one way, and no return to the grid, go round the back of the container and out the gate field on return.
- Dogs are permitted but must never be taken on the kart track, the dummy grid and surrounding parc ferme areas. They must be kept on a lead or in a vehicle and any mess cleared up. Penalty for non-observance is to leave the site.
- No starting of engines in the pits, first occurrence fine of £50, subsequent expulsion from the site. There is an area next to the dummy grid where they may be started for a maximum of 10 seconds, this is not a warm up area.
- No lifting of the rear of karts on the grid to warm up engines, first offence £50, subsequent offence expulsion from the site.
- If pushers are permitted for Bambino, Cadet or Junior classes, maximum of 6 on the track, well spaced out. Orange tabards and a briefing are mandatory.
- Karts must not be lifted over fences, there are three exits that can be used for stranded karts at the Wilkins hairpin, behind lap-scoring and at the Stratford hairpin.
- No standing on fences e.g. whilst spectating, no signalling to drivers is permitted from trackside
- Stakes must not be driven into tarmac areas, use weights if necessary to hold awnings down. Fine of £50 for each offence.
- If an exhaust becomes broken, stop at the nearest safe place on the track for later retrieval.
- Do not spill or dispose of any fuel on the ground, especially tarmac, use a container for safe disposal later.
- All generators must be switched off between the hours of 2300 and 0700.
- The gate to the public road will be locked between 2300 and approximately 0700/0730. There is a pedestrian gate adjacent.
- Drones or model aeroplanes are not permitted at any time.
- Stepladders or temporary structures for viewing adjacent to the track perimeter are forbidden.
- The non-spectator areas of the surrounding grass banks are out of bounds, as are the agricultural storage areas.
- Do enjoy your visit to Shenington and observe the rules.
